Junior Art Show Entry Form

Jr. Art will be displayed in the Board Room

- 1. All Shoreline area students (K-12) may submit their favorite artwork to the Cromwell Room in the Shoreline Center on **Wednesday**, **June 4**, **3:00-5:00 p.m.** The Center is located at 18560 1st Ave NE.
- 2. Work will be juried for display and awards. Award winners will be contacted via email prior to the Festival. Presentation of Awards will be publicly announced at a ceremony at the event on Saturday June 28.
- 3. Work in all media will be accepted. Size is limited to **no larger than 24 x 36" including mat board**. No unfired clay or greenware will be accepted. **Maximum 1 entry per student**. Piece must be the original work of the student.
- 4. All artwork should be <u>unframed</u> and mounted on stiff mat board or cardboard. <u>Do not mount work on foam core, as it is too</u> <u>difficult to hang</u>. The label below must be firmly attached to the back as directed to be accepted in the show.
- 5. Up to 15 pieces will be selected for the Shoreline School District's 2014-2015 Calendar. Originals will be returned.
- 6. PICK-UP: Artwork <u>must be picked up on Sunday, June 29, 2014</u>, in the School Board Room between <u>5:00 and 6:00 p.m.</u>., at the END of the Festival. Return of artwork left after this time cannot be guaranteed.
- 7. TEACHERS: If you bring in student art work from your class room you are also responsible to pick up the art work on Sunday. Many of these students & parents do not even realize that their art work is at the festival and do not know to come pick it up. If you are not able to pick it up that Sunday, June 29, arrangements must be made at the time of drop off to pick up the artwork between July 7 and July 24.
